Sainsbury's Active Kids Vouchers

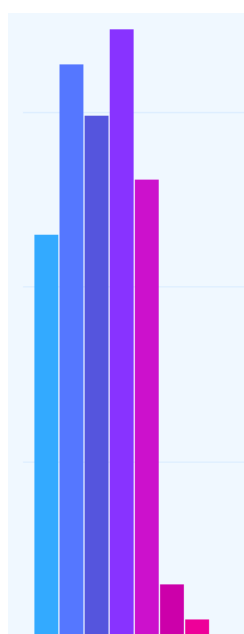
We are now collecting Sainsbury's Active Kids Vouchers. Any vouchers you have would be greatly received. Students can deposit them in the box at student reception.

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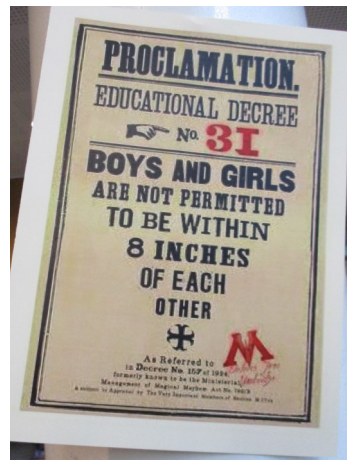


Harry Potter Book Night
