

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




Manga Competition Winner

A group of more than 20 of our Year 9 Students enjoyed the Academy's first ever trip to New York at the end of last term.



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


Computer Programming

Can we please remind all parents/carers to consider others when parking your cars at dropping off and collecting times at Kettering Science Academy.


We have recently received complaints from residents in the area who have been inconvenienced by parents' parked cars left in the way of driveways and limiting the access to their homes.
