

## **Kettering Science Academy Parent/Carer Survey Feedback November 2020**

"I thank everyone for doing an amazing job at my son school for making sure everything include them are stay safe and well."

The survey was taken as a follow-up to previous surveys in May, June and July 2020 which were carried out to gain an understanding of how families were coping during the school closure period due to COVID-19 and identify what could be done to provide further support.

292 parents of 341 students completed the survey in October 2020. This represents approximately **28%** of the whole student population.

**81%** of parents stated they believe the school has communicated well.

The average score for 'In general, how are your family coping from 1-10?' was **8.1**. We will make (or already have made) contact with all families who identified as 4 or below.

84% of parents know who to contact if they have a concern.

The average score for 'How confident do you feel supporting your child learning?' was 6.4.

The average score for 'How confident do you feel ensuring your child is safe online?' was 8.2.
