Easter Holidays

The Easter holidays begin on Monday 6th April. Staff will not be setting work during these two weeks. School will remain open only for essential provision for key workers and specific groups, who we have already made contact with. If you are planning to send your child in (only if absolutely necessary) please let us know by emailing Claire Greaves, Designated Safeguarding Lead, cgreaves@ketteringscienceacademy.org. We will not be able to provide care for your children unless we know in advance they are coming.

Being the best you can be


