- Meet the Tutor Evening Wednesday 26th September: This event is open to all year groups and provides a great opportunity to meet your child's tutor and discuss how they are settling in. The tutor is a key person in your child's school life, so we encourage you to attend if possible.
- School Photos Wednesday, 11th September: Many students have asked me to inform you so they can prepare! As a parent of three daughters, I understand how important this day can be for some. For some children, school photo day can be a source of anxiety. If you feel your child may need extra support, please do not hesitate to inform their form tutor.

PE Kit and Uniform Updates

- PE Kit: Starting this year, students should come to school in their PE kit on days when they have PE or dance lessons, as both are practical sessions.
- Uniform: The Uniform Boot Room will be open from Monday. We've spoken with students about any necessary adjustments to their uniform, and from Monday, we expect all students to be in correct uniform. If your child has specific sensory needs that require adjustments, please discuss these with the school and we will be more than happy to work with you to ensure this is not a barrier for children.
