Cold Weather & Uniform Update

As the colder weather sets in, we want to ensure students stay comfortable while maintaining a conducive learning environment. Just like last year, we'll be allowing students to:

• Wear their coats around the school building.

However, during lesson times, we ask that coats are **not worn in classrooms** unless a teacher deems the room too cold. If a classroom is considered chilly, teachers will let students know, and coats will be permitted in those instances.

We do, however, make **reasonable adjustments** to accommodate specific needs of staff or students, including those arising from disabilities. I appreciate that this may raise questions, particularly when students perceive this as inconsistent. However, it is important to distinguish between accommodations made for disability and the general rules that apply to the wider school community. We remain committed to ensuring our policies are **fair** and **practical** while respecting the needs of all individuals within our school.

In line with feedback from parents last year about the visibility of dark-coloured outerwear, we would like to clarify that:

- There is no expectation for students to wear dark-coloured coats
- We do require **outdoor coats (not hoodies)** for warmth.

We appreciate your support in helping students follow this expectation, as it contributes to a respectful and focused atmosphere in the classroom. Please also remember that:

- Students should wear either a blazer or jumper underneath their coat.
- Hoodies are not permitted, except for the school PE jumper during PE lessons.

Thank you for understanding as we work to keep the school environment comfortable for everyone.

Parking in Disabled Bays

We kindly ask parents to be mindful of parking in the disabled bays on our school grounds. This week, several of our disabled members of staff have reported difficulties accessing the designated parking spaces as they have been occupied by non-designated vehicles. We ask that these bays are left free for those who need them to ensure everyone can park safely and access the school with ease.

Parents using the disabled bays should have a disability badge clearly visible in the windscreen to ensure these spaces are available to those who require them. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation in making sure everyone has equal access to parking.
