Dear Parent/carer,

As you know the students have been working this term to develop their grades to enable the issuing of Centre Assessed Grades, which have replaced the usual exam results. This assessment period will run up to Friday 28th May, and we expect all students in year 11 to attend as usual. On that Friday, COVID restrictions allowing we will be holding an assembly to celebrate all the students' hard work over what has been a very difficult time for them.

Following the half-term holiday Kettering Science Academy will be providing a full online package for all students to follow up until 25th June, which is the statutory leaving date. Students unless particularly invited in will not be required to learn onsite during this time, and may follow the online programme at home.

The online programme will continue to strengthen their knowledge of the core curriculum areas after half term remotely using Teams. Students will be able to check in daily with a member of the pastoral team every day and complete the work set. Students can access the work set from the Year 11 Team. They have been well practiced at this during our recent lockdown.
