Dear parents and carers,

**Co -Curricular Activities Term 1 – Tuesday Wednesday and Thursday 3-4pm**

I am happy to tell you we are starting co- curricular clubs from Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> September. These clubs will run for 1 term until Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> October. The clubs will now be mixed year groups giving more opportunities.

It is expected **all pupils** will attend and take part in one co- curricular activity for one hour after school on one day of the week. Students can do more than one club a week i.e. football Tuesday, homework Wednesday and cooking Thursday, but they must commit to attending the weekly session. If your child normally gets the bus or is picked up please make arrangements to collect them at 4pm as unfortunately we cannot provide school transport at this time.

On Friday 10<sup>th</sup> September you will receive many invites to clubs via Edulink. Please wait until Friday at 5pm when you will have received them all before signing up. They can only do one club on each day please pay attention to this when booking. By signing up on Edulink you are giving parental permission for them to attend and they will be expected to attend that club every week for this term. There will be no movement between clubs and students will not be able to attend without parental permission. Clubs will be allocated on a first come first served basis. If when you try to sign up to a club it is full please look for another option. There will be new opportunities at the start of each term so students can swap clubs at that time.

The aim of co-curricular activities is to develop and enhance academic, social and emotional skills while promoting co-operation leadership and team work. There is also an opportunity to build new friendships across year groups as the clubs are now mixed.

Students have had an assembly explaining about how co curriculum works and will know what is available although they may not be invited to everything. Some clubs have targeted groups to enhance academic performance or support specific students.

Clubs are free and the only requirement is that your child brings their PE kit if they are taking part in a physical activity.
