Firstly I would like to thank you all for your support and cooperation in what has been a very challenging and difficult year for us all. The Covid pandemic has been a real challenge for education and will continue to be and I would like to assure you that both myself and my staff at Kettering Science Academy will continue to do our very best to maintain the highest possible standards of education into the new year.


I would like to just mention our arrangements for the new term in January 2022. Due to the government advising testing of students before school starts, we are having a staggered return for each year group to allow us to do this. The year groups will return to school as follows;

Wednesday 5th January - years 7, 11 and sixth form, Thursday 6th January - all of the above, plus years 9 and 10, Friday 7th January - all of the above plus year 8.

As advised in my previous letter on return to school after the Christmas break, the DfE has asked that all students are offered an onsite lateral flow tests. By testing we will help to reduce the spread in school and college settings through asymptomatic transmission. I am therefore encouraging students to be tested. However, for clarity the testing is optional, please follow this link and complete the consent form should you wish your child to take part in testing: https://forms.office.com/r/P9h0j6kUa7. Please note that the deadline to complete the form is Sunday 19th December at 5pm.
