CDTRT

Our Caught Doing The Right Thing initiative officially launched this week and seems to be a big hit! Students have voted for the prizes which they wish to see this half term and we have gone with an iPad, x-box, wireless headphones and love to shop vouchers. I ordered 100,000 CDTRT tickets as I know how many we will be giving out as we reward our students for doing the right thing even when no-one is looking. Students know that these will be given for meeting our basic expectations throughout the school day and, as such, are available for every young person to achieve. Please have a chat with your child about how many they have already got and which prize they are going for.

Parent Governors

You'll have heard me say before that it's incredibly important to me that we hear the voices of everyone at the Academy, and you play an equally vital part in that as our parents. We are looking to add to our existing governors by inviting any parents who wish to join our Local Governing Board. The commitment is three formal meetings a year, with other ad hoc visits and support throughout the year. The role of parent governor is a vital one at the school and I would encourage you to have a think about whether this is something you could contribute to. It's important to say that the parent governor role does not provide a forum for discussing individual issues related to your child and you are elected to be representative of the parent voice as a whole.
