**Documentary photography**  
 usually refers to a popular form of **photography** used to record chronicle events or environments both significant and relevant to history, historical events as well as everyday life.



**Photo-journalism**  
 In which a written copy is subordinate to pictorial usually photographic presentation of news stories or in which a high proportion of pictorial presentation is used; broadly : news **photography**.



**Location photography**  
 Shooting is the shooting of a film or television production in a real-world setting rather than a sound stage or backlot. Before filming/shooting, the locations are generally surveyed in pre-production, a process known as location scouting and recce.
