Year 7 ethics unit 3: Should animals have rights?

Overview

This unit follows on from Unit 2 on Introduction to Morality. The Western religions of Christianity, Judaism and Islam suggest that although all forms of life were created by God, there is a hierarchy of species with humans described as having dominion over the animals. What that actually means is open to debate. The eastern religions of Hinduism, Buddhism and Sikhism teach that al forms of life are equally precious because all forms of life are interlinked.

What are the views of religions on the uses of animals? What do religions teach about the treatment of animals?













