



READING THE **TREBLE CLEF:**



**KEY TERMS:**

TRIPLET	A portion of musical time that's been split rhythmically into three equal parts
KEY SIGNATURE	Any of several combinations of sharps or flats after the clef at the beginning of each stave, indicating the key of a composition.
TIME SIGNATURE	An indication of rhythm following a clef.
DOTTED NOTE	A note written with a dot after it, which has one and a half times the length of the same note without a dot.
DYNAMIC	An indication of the volume of a piece of music.




